# **Inclusive Church motion at APCM**

There will be a proposal at the APCM that St Anne's becomes registered as an Inclusive Church.

To do so we need to agree to a resolution that we support the Inclusive Church statement of belief as below.

"We believe in inclusive Church - church which does not discriminate, on any level, on grounds of economic power, gender, mental health, physical ability, race or sexuality. We believe in Church which welcomes and serves all people in the name of Jesus Christ; which is scripturally faithful; which seeks to proclaim the Gospel afresh for each generation; and which, in the power of the Holy Spirit, allows all people to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Jesus Christ."
