St Albans Pilgrimage 22nd of June

We will join the Alban Pilgrimage - a magnificent procession organised by St Albans Cathedral, to celebrate St Alban, Britain's first saint.

Each year, 12ft tall carnival puppets, representing figures from the story of St Alban, take to the streets to re-enact the historic events which led to St Alban's execution at the hands of the Romans. The puppets are accompanied by people of all ages dressed as lions, Roman soldiers, angels, chariots and more, resulting in a stunning spectacle of colour and celebration.

After the procession arrives at the Cathedral, services take place throughout the rest of the afternoon. You can also join us on the Abbey Orchard for Alban Fest, an afternoon of fun Roman themed activities, part of our Roman Festival, from 12pm until 6pm. Or find a tea shop and take a pause.

Children, teenagers and young adults play a part in this truly unique event by dressing up as characters and operating the puppets as they walk in the steps of Saint Alban and tell his remarkable story. Children need to be registered.
