Items we will need are the usual:

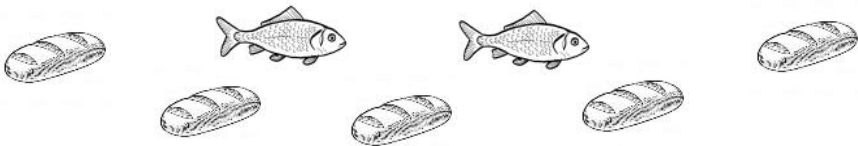
Tins: meat, fish, vegetables, soups, baked beans, spaghetti hoops, custard, rice pudding, and fruit.

*shoes- trainers, boots, comfy shoes in useable condition, any size

*any rucksacks or easy to carry bags
