One of our neighbours, Seren, has teamed up with us to trial a project to give local young people the opportunity to get work experience. The project is to open an organic juice bar for the summer. The juice bar will be based in a temporary unit in the church garden by the double gates. The aim is to employ young people who are looking for first time employment in order to offer them initial work experience that can then set them off into the working world. By working in an organic juice bar they will learn about health and safety, personal health and how to run a small business. The juice bar will be open from Mon-Sat from around 8am until 4pm.
