LENT GROUPS

We will be joining with St Agnes and other churches in following the Lent course “Face to Face – the Journey towards Reconciliation”.

Face to face is a six week devotional course that takes us on a journey towards reconciliation in relationships. The journey focuses on the story of Esau and Jacob, from Genesis 25-33, in which we find principles that can help us journey towards reconciliation. This course is accompanied by a handbook which leads us through each session. It includes key points and biblical passages as well as group questions to help guide discussions.

Hazelnut community Farm

The PCC is considering the proposal for Hazelnut Community Farm to be based at St Anne's. They will meet on Sunday afternoons, primarily in the garden, but also the Church Hall. They will manage the garden as a community garden. They run events and courses for other churches and faith groups to learn how to use their gardens and open spaces. They will grow and give away fruit and vegetables. Hazelnut Community Farm has been using land in Horfield but they are looking for a new base to develop and grow. Their mission is to follow the creator God and be inspired by permaculture principles in order to create natural spaces of peace that have social innovation, economic inclusion, political and spiritual transformation at their heart.
