Priority Community Network Funding

St Anne's has been identified as a parish in the 12% most deprived communities according to Government statistics. As such we are eligible for Priority Communities Network (PCN) Funds from the Diocese.

This will be used for pay for two roles:

An administrator based in an Operational Hub to provide administrative support to the three incumbents, of St Agnes' and St Anne's, St Mary's Fishponds, and St Luke's Barton Hill. This person will be based at St Agnes.

A Lay Ministry role – one full time equivalent per incumbent – in our case 0.3 at St Anne's – approx. 11 hours per week. It need not be the same person in both parishes. This is for ministry in a missional context, linked with the diocese's policy on social justice, for those living in deprived areas, with a faith and kingdom perspective.

The PCC will be forming a committee to research local needs and make a proposal for this role. If you have any views or an interest in being on the committee speak to Carla or Val.
