Thank you for the warm welcome. I always enjoy our visits.

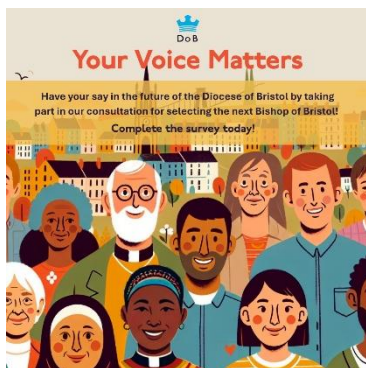
I just wanted to let you know that the collection tin contained £134 which I thought was very generous indeed.
